

The 2015 AMMCS-CAIMS Congress

Instructions for Poster Presenters

- Posters should be prepared and printed in advance and be brought in person by the author(s). Posters should be on display during all poster sessions of the congress. Poster boards will be available starting Tuesday afternoon, and we request to put your poster on prior to the first poster session on Wednesday morning.
- The poster stands are sized 3' x 4', that is approximately 90cm x 120 cm (width x height). Pushpins for attaching the posters to the stands are provided by the conference organizers.
- The poster stands are numbered from 1 onwards. The stand number allocated to your presentation is shown in the conference program.
- The presenting author must be at the poster only during the poster sessions. Please consult the program on the location and time slots for your poster session.

Other Important Issues:

There are no specific constraints in the layout of the poster other than the following:

- The title and the names of authors should be prominently displayed and the character size of lettering should be large enough to allow reading from a distance of 1 meter.
- Include the title of the paper on the top of the poster, in capital letters (with lettering at least 4 cm in height). Insert author names and affiliations below the title. The flow of the poster should be from the top left to the bottom right. Multiple columns can also be used.
- Using figures, graphics and colors to illustrate and better visualize your presentation is highly recommended. A printed version of the paper is not considered to be a poster!
- Presentations should be self-explanatory so that the presenter is free to supplement and discuss particular points.
